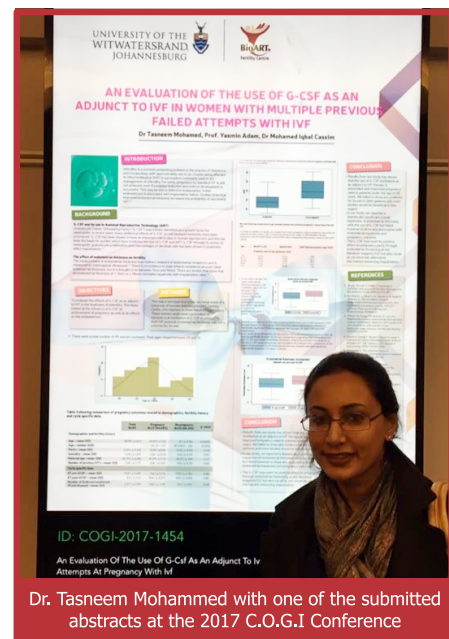


## BioART wins International Award at the 2017 C.O.G.I. conference Austria, Vienna
